Comments for the week ending January 5, 2006

The finished cattle market was under some pressure this week. The volume of live finished steers and heifers sold through auction markets was 1,944. That volume is double of what traded in the same period last year. The average fed steer price was \$102.39 down \$3.75 and the average heifer price was \$100.27 down \$4.39 from last week. Auction markets reported fed cattle sold barely steady to \$2 lower. The yearly average for finished steers was \$90.84 up \$13.64 from 2004, up \$6.15 from 2003 and down \$12.33 from 2002.

Slaughter cows sold on a good demand. There were 2,604 head sold through auction markets. This week's average price was \$31.11 down \$1.88 from last week but \$5.42 higher than two weeks ago. Auction markets reported cows sold strong with prices \$2 higher. The average price for 2005 was \$27.01 up \$8.20 from 2004, down \$11.74 from 2003 and down \$30.67 from 2002.

Replacement cattle sold strong. Total stockers sold was 2,771 down 8% from last year at this time. Auction markets reported stockers sold actively on a good demand at fully steady prices.

Direct to packer railgrade cattle prices were \$3.50 higher. Steers and heifers sold at \$173.00-178.00 dressed.

In Alberta, cattle trade was only moderate with steady prices. Steers sold at \$93.00-96.65 live and \$159.00-160.85 flat rail. Heifers sold at \$95.10-96.95 live and \$159.00-160.50 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade was light with prices \$1 lower. Steers and heifers sold at \$93.00-96.00 live and \$150.00 dressed.
