Comments for the week ending Oct 19, 2006

Cattle prices were under pressure all the way across the board this week. The number of live finished steers and heifers sold through auction markets was 2,091 up 201 over last week. The average fed steer price was \$89.76 down \$1.29 and the average heifer price was \$87.92 down \$3.72 from last week. Auction markets reported fed cattle sold on a moderate demand with prices steady to \$2.00 lower.

Slaughter cows were stronger early in the week and lost ground as the week progressed. There were 2,241 head of slaughter cows sold through auction markets which is 479 higher than last week. The average price was \$33.45 down \$1.12 from last week and \$6.64 higher than a year ago. Auction markets reported that slaughter cows sold steady to \$2.00 higher early in the week to easier to \$1.00 lower late in the week.

Replacement cattle saw lower prices in every weight category. The total number of stockers sold was 11,006 up 8.1% over last week and 18% less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported that calves traded barely steady to \$10.00 lower while yearlings sold steady to \$4.00 lower. Steers 900 + averaged \$105.24 down \$6.97 and heifers 800+ averaged \$101.34 down \$3.59 from last weeks prices. Steers 400-500 lbs averaged \$130.24 down \$5.64 while heifers 400-500 lbs averaged \$120.57 down \$3.23 from last week.

Ontario railgrade prices reported for this week were \$153.00-\$157.00 for steers and \$153.00-\$154.00 for heifers, which was on average \$1.50 lower than last week.

In Alberta, cattle trade was moderate to active with prices steady to \$1.00 higher. Steers sold \$83.80-\$86.75 live and \$140.30-\$142.35 dressed. Heifers traded \$84.75-\$86.05 live and \$140.50-\$141.50 dressed.

U.S. cash cattle trade was quiet with just a few scattered sales on Thursday in the north at \$135.00 dressed. Significant trade is not expected until after the release of the cattle on feed report late Friday afternoon.

Local beef trade reported a steady week. End cuts are moving well while the middle cuts are lighter.
