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Comments for the week ending March 1, 2007

The finished cattle sold on a strong active trade this week. The number of live finished steers and heifers sold through auction markets was steady to last week. The average fed steer price was \$99.08 up \$0.94 from last week and \$2.95 higher than last year at this time. The average heifer price was \$97.71 up \$2.02 from last week and \$5.09 higher than the same time last year. Auction markets reported fed cattle sold actively with prices \$1.00-\$3.00 stronger than last week.

Slaughter cows continued to sell strong and steady. The volume of slaughter cows sold through auction markets was 1,646 down 360 from last week. The average price was \$35.08 down \$0.08 from last week and \$5.34 higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported that slaughter cows sold actively on a strong market with prices steady to \$2.00 higher.

Replacement cattle sold on a moderate to good demand this week. There were 4,033 replacements sold through auction markets, up 4.3% from last week and 12% more than last year at this time. Weekly average prices were \$0.56 higher to \$6.98 lower with lightweight cattle seeing the largest average price decline. Auction markets reported replacement cattle as trading steady to stronger.

Ontario railgrade prices reported for steers for the previous Friday were \$160.00-\$167.00 increasing to \$165.00-\$167.00 by Wednesday. Heifers were \$159.00-\$166.00 the previous Friday and \$164.00-\$166.00 by Wednesday, which is on average \$1.50 higher than last week.

In Alberta, cattle trade was light to active with prices slightly higher than last week. Steers sold \$90.15-\$92.45 live and \$150.00-\$153.30 dressed. Heifers traded \$90.75-\$92.20 live and \$150.00-\$153.30 dressed.

U.S. cash cattle trade saw a handful of sales in Nebraska midweek at prices \$146.00 dressed. At time of reporting (Friday) fairly active trade had developed with prices \$5.00 higher on dressed cattle and \$3.00-\$4.00 higher on live cattle. Steers and heifers sold \$93.00-\$95.00 live and \$148.00-\$150.00 dressed.

Local beef trade reported movement as quiet the last couple of weeks with some improvement on Wednesday. Cutout prices remain strong on all cuts reflecting live cattle prices.
