Comments for the week ending May 3, 2007

The fed cattle market bounced back a little price wise, but was lower in volume this week. The number of live finished steers and heifers sold through auction markets was 1,364, down 395 from last week. The average fed steer price was \$106.66 up \$1.42 from last week. The average heifer price was \$104.35 up \$1.25 from last week. Auction markets reported fed cattle sold stronger this week with prices fully steady to \$2.00 higher.

Slaughter cows saw softer prices this week. The volume of slaughter cows sold through auction markets was 1,949 up 135 from last week. The average price was \$43.60 down \$2.23 from last week and \$10.44 higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported that cows sold on a good demand with prices fully steady to \$2.00 lower.

Replacement cattle sold on a mixed demand. There were 12,735 replacements sold through auction markets, up 8.1% from last week and 32% more than last year at this time. Auction markets reported strong active trade with grass type cattle trading steady to strong and heavier cattle were reported as steady to under pressure.

Ontario railgrade prices this week were \$1.75 lower on average from last week. Railgrade prices reported for steers were \$177.00-\$181.00 and heifers sold \$176.00-\$180.00.

In Alberta, cattle trade was active with prices holding steady to last week. Steers traded \$100.50-\$104.00 live and \$166.80-\$174.25 flat rail. Heifers sold \$101.00-\$104.45 live and \$169.50-\$171.00 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade was active in the north on Thursday with prices fully steady to last week at \$154.00-\$155.00 dressed. Light trade in the south on Thursday saw prices \$0.50-\$1.00 lower from \$95.00-\$95.50 live. Friday's business in the south was active with prices fully steady to last week at \$96.00-\$96.50 live.

Local beef trade reported that business was consistent to last week with middle cuts selling very strong and priced accordingly. End cuts are struggling which is reflected in the cutout prices. It is anticipated that this summer's beef trade will be very similar to last summer. Kills remain steady at this time.
