Comments for the week ending June 14, 2007

Fed cattle were lighter in all aspects this week. The number of live finished steers and heifers sold through auction markets was 913 down 412 from last week. The average fed steer price was \$100.50 down \$1.75 from last week and \$4.90 higher than last year at this time. The average heifer price was \$98.63 down \$0.87 from last week and \$5.00 higher than the same time last year. Auction markets reported fed cattle sold at prices steady through most of the week with one report of \$2.00 higher.

Slaughter cows saw a stronger market this week. The volume of slaughter cows sold through auction markets was 1,387 down 444 from last week. The average price was \$44.17 up \$0.93 from last week and \$7.79 higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported that cows sold actively at prices steady to strong.

There were 3,795 replacements sold through auction markets, down 23.2% from last week and 31% more than last year at this time. Auction markets reported a continued strong demand with prices remaining steady to firm with reports of medium quality offerings.

Ontario railgrade prices continued on a downward trend. Steers traded \$170.00-\$173.00 early week to \$165.00-171.00 mid to late week, which is on average \$5.00 lower than last week.

Heifers followed the same trend with prices \$169.00-\$170.00 early week to \$164.00-170.00 mid week, which is on average \$6.00 lower than last week.

In Alberta, cattle trade was slightly lower again this week. Prices this week were \$1.00-\$2.00 lower on Wednesday with a firmer undertone on Thursday. Steers traded from \$87.30-\$90.60 live and \$147.00-\$150.55 flat rail. Heifers sold \$88.85-\$89.55 live and \$147.00-\$150.00 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade was active in the north on Wednesday with prices \$3.00 lower as steers and heifers traded from \$139.00-\$142.00 dressed. Thursday saw active trade in the south with prices \$1.00 lower as cattle traded from \$90.00-\$90.50 live.
