Comments for the week ending July 26, 2007

Fed cattle saw an easier week in both volume and pricing. The number of live finished steers and heifers sold through auction markets was 1,280 down 322 from last week. The average fed steer price was \$93.96 down \$1.71 from last week and \$3.08 higher than last year at this time. Heifers were under a little more pressure than steers with the average heifer price at \$89.70 down \$4.92 and \$0.78 higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported finished cattle sold steady to \$3.00 lower.

The slaughter cow market lost last week's gain and is fully steady to two weeks ago. The volume of slaughter cows sold through auction markets was 1,398. The average price was \$38.26 down \$1.31 from last week and \$2.32 lower than last year at this time. Auction markets reported cows sold actively with prices reported as steady to \$2.00 higher.

Replacement cattle prices were slightly lower this week. The majority of the volume sold was heavier, shortkeep cattle while the volume of lightweight cattle traded was extremely light. There were 2,627 replacements sold through auction markets, down 21.9% from last week and 8% more than last year at this time. Auction markets reported a good demand on shortkeep cattle. Steers were reported as trading from steady to barely steady while heifers sold steady to \$2.00 lower.

Ontario railgrade prices reported for this week were \$2.50-\$3.00 lower on average with the prices declining as the week progressed. Steers traded from \$155.00-\$162.00 while heifers sold \$154.00-\$161.00 dressed.

Alberta's fed cattle market saw moderate to active trade with prices holding steady to last week. Steers sold \$83.30-85.75 live and \$139.00-141.30 flat rail. Heifers traded from \$83.85-84.55 live and \$138.50 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade was very late getting started this week. At the time of reporting Friday afternoon, fairly active trade had developed in the north with prices \$2.00-\$3.00 higher ranging from \$142.00-\$143.00 dressed. Only moderate trade was evident in the south with prices \$1.00-\$1.50 higher as steers and heifers traded from \$91.00-\$91.50 live.
