Comments for the week ending March 12, 2009

The fed cattle market continues to see light receipts at auction markets with prices stronger this week. There were 1,194 fed cattle sold through auction markets this week down 45 from last week and 858 less than the same time last year. Steers ranged from \$95.24-\$102.24 averaging \$99.51 up \$2.27 from last week and \$15.39 stronger than last year at this time. Heifers traded from \$92.42-\$101.35 averaging \$97.77 up \$1.79 from last week and \$13.09 higher than year ago prices. Auction markets reported good strong active trading. Early week prices were reported as steady to fully steady. As the week progressed prices were reported from fully steady to \$2.00 higher.

The slaughter cow market was slightly higher again this week. There were 2,402 slaughter cows sold through auction markets down 29 from last week and 66 more than last year at this time. Slaughter cows traded from \$39.93-\$57.70 averaging \$49.19 up \$0.66 from last week and \$6.70 higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported a strong active trade with prices \$1.00-\$2.00 higher.

There were 4,034 replacements sold through auction markets down 13% from last week and 4% less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported a good demand with active trading with prices from steady to \$3.00 higher. Heifers 700-800 lbs saw the largest average price increase at \$100.60 up \$8.68 over last week. Heifers 800 lbs + were \$1.24 lower on average and steers 900 lbs + were \$1.69 lower on average. All other weight categories were steady to \$4.00 higher.

Ontario railgrade prices reported this week grew stronger at the week progressed. Steers started the week at \$163-\$166 with sales at \$166-\$167 by mid week. Heifers followed the same trend with early prices at \$162-\$165 to \$165-\$166 by mid week. The average price was \$1.00 higher than last week.

Alberta's fed cattle market active with prices \$2.50 stronger than last week. Steers traded from \$90.50-\$93.00 live and \$156.00-\$156.85 flat rail. Heifers sold at \$90.50-\$92.80 live and \$154.00-\$156.85 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade on Thursday morning was moderate to active trade in the north with prices \$1.00-\$2.00 lower at \$128-\$129 dressed. Cattle futures rallied and afternoon trade was stronger with dressed sales at \$130, steady to last week. Southern trade Thursday morning was \$1.00 lower at \$81.00 live but business came to a standstill after the futures strengthened and sellers held out for better prices. Friday, at time of reporting, the cash cattle trade remains at a standstill. It appears that the north is finished for the week after good movement yesterday, however the south still has a fair amount of cattle to sell. Asking prices are at \$84.00 live.
