### **Comments for the week ending April 2, 2009**

The fed cattle market saw very little change this week. There were 1,237 fed cattle sold through auction markets up 65 from last week and 727 less than last year at this time. The average price for steers was \$98.88 up \$0.81 from last week and \$14.76 stronger than last year at this time. Heifers traded for an average price of \$97.86 down \$0.07 from last week and \$14.51 higher than last year. The price range for steers was \$93.19-\$102.62 and heifers \$93.87-\$101.25. Auction market reports early week saw prices fully steady to \$2.00 lower. As the week progressed prices were reported as fully steady to \$2.00 higher.

The slaughter cow market saw a good strong week of trade. There were 2,213 slaughter cows sold through auction markets down 192 from last week and 1,387 less than last year at this time. Slaughter cows ranged from \$41.31-\$58.91 with an average price of \$50.21, up \$2.17 from last week and \$7.16 stronger than last year at this time.

Auction markets all reported strong active trading with prices ranging from \$1.00-\$5.00 higher.

The replacement cattle trade saw lighter receipt this week with mixed prices. There were 4,421 replacements sold through auction markets down 31.5% from last week and 20% less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported light weight grass types as trading from steady to \$3.00 higher. Heavier cattle were reported as fully steady to a slight decline. Actual average prices saw steers and heifers 400 lbs & under up \$3.34-\$4.44 on average. Steers 500-800 lbs averaged \$2.00-\$5.81 lower, steers 800-900 steady and steers 900 lbs plus were \$3.44 lower on average. Heifers 500-700 lbs averaged \$1.00-\$4.00 lower, heifers 700-800 lbs averaged \$2.58 higher and heifers \$800 lbs plus averaged \$2.28 lower than last week.

Ontario railgrade prices reported for this week averaged \$0.75 lower than last week. Steers started off the week at \$167-\$171 up to \$167-\$172 by mid week. Heifers traded from \$166-\$170 early week to \$166-\$171 by mid week.

Alberta's fed cattle market was \$1.00-\$2.00 higher than last week. Steers traded from \$96.45-\$98.50 live and \$163.50-\$164.85 flat rail. Heifers sold at \$94.65-\$96.90 live and \$163.50-\$163.85 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade late last Friday was steady to \$1.00 higher than the previous week with sales from \$83.00-\$84.00 live and \$133.00-\$134.00 dressed. This week the market has remained untested. At time of reporting Friday afternoon, a handful of sales in the north by one regional buyer were reported at \$135.00 dressed, otherwise business is quiet. Asking prices are holding firm at \$86.00 live and \$136.00 dressed with active trade expected to surface in the next several hours with higher prices.
