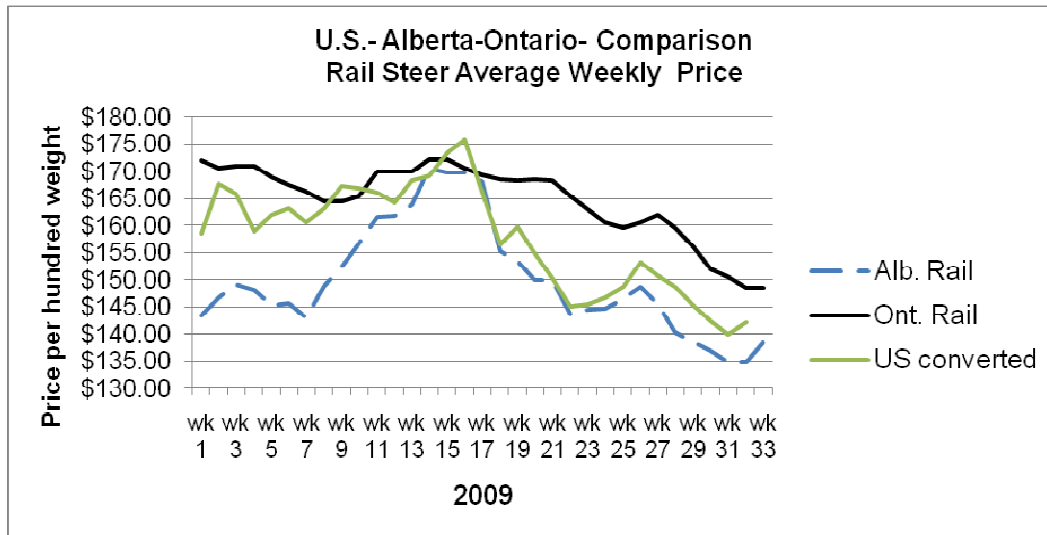

Comments for the week ending Aug 20, 2009

The fed cattle market held steady this week. There were 735 fed cattle sold through auction markets which steady to last week and 1,028 less than last year at this time. Steers sold from \$81.93-\$90.92 averaging \$87.09 up \$0.22 from last week but \$13.17 lower than last year at this time. Heifers traded from \$71.51-\$90.74 averaging \$83.92 down \$0.44 from last week and \$15.10 lower than year ago prices. Auction markets reported steady prices with one report of second cut cattle under some pressure.

The slaughter cow market was slightly stronger this week. There were 1,721 slaughter cows sold through auction markets up 234 from last week and 203 less than the same time last year. Slaughter cows traded from \$36.97-\$53.77 averaging \$45.03 up \$0.63 from last week and \$11.28 lower than this time last year. Auction markets reported prices from steady to \$1.00 higher.

The replacement cattle market traded on a mixed demand this week. There were 3,351 replacements sold through auction markets, up 24% from last week and 9% less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported sales from steady to firm to under pressure. One auction reported heifers as trading \$3.00 lower. Actual average prices saw steers 700-900 lbs steady to \$3.32 stronger and heifers 700-800 lbs \$4.46 higher. Steers 900+ and heifers 800+ were \$1.15-\$1.63 lower on average. All other categories were down \$0.77-\$6.16 on average.

Ontario railgrade prices remained fully steady to last week. Steers were reported at \$146.00-\$151.00 and heifers \$145.00-\$150.00.

Alberta's fed cattle market was active with prices \$2.00 stronger than last week. Steers traded from \$80.75-83.50 live and \$137.50-138.85 flat rail. Heifers traded from \$80.75-83.30 live and \$137.50-138.85 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade was quiet until Friday when active trade in the north saw most sales at \$131.00 dressed, up \$1.00 from last week. The south remains untested and is not likely to develop until after the Cattle on Feed Report is released later in the afternoon today. Asking prices in the south are at \$84.00-\$85.00 live while bids are at \$81.00-\$83.00 live.
