Comments for the week ending Sept 3, 2009

The fed cattle market was steady this week. There were 946 fed cattle sold through auction markets up 173 from last week and 11 less than last year at this time. Steers sold from \$82.99-\$92.87 averaging \$87.71 up \$0.34 from last week and \$9.41 lower than last year at this time. Heifers ranged from \$80.05-\$89.94 averaging \$85.48 up \$0.01 from last week and \$6.82 lower than year ago prices. Auction markets reported a moderate to good demand with prices from slightly stronger to \$1.00 higher.

The slaughter cow market also traded steady this week. There were 1,981 slaughter cows sold through auction markets down 33 from last week and 127 more than the same time last year. Slaughter cows ranged from \$33.71-\$48.85 averaging \$41.35 down \$0.01 from last week and \$11.89 lower than this time last year. Auction markets reports saw prices mostly steady with one report of prices under pressure from the US dairy cow sell-off.

Replacement cattle receipts were lighter this week as there were 3,165 head sold through auction markets, down 45% from last week and 36% less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported a selective demand with prices from steady to under pressure at \$1.00-\$2.00 lower. Actual average prices saw steers under 400 lbs \$6.46 lower with steers 500-900 lbs averaging \$1.46-\$6.04 stronger and steers 900 lbs plus down \$0.08 on average. Heifers 500-600 lbs averaged \$0.10 higher while all other categories averaged \$0.71-\$3.55 lower.

Ontario railgrade prices improved very slightly as the week progressed. Steers were reported at \$147-\$152 early week and \$149-\$152 by mid week. Heifers followed the same trend with early week prices reported at \$146-\$151 and \$148-\$151 by mid week. This week's prices average \$1.25 higher than last week. Prices will trend lower next week.

Alberta's fed cattle market was moderate with prices \$0.54-\$0.75 lower on average. Steers traded at \$83.15-\$85.45 live and \$141.50-\$141.85 flat rail while heifers were reported at \$81.00-\$83.75 live and \$141.85 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade on Thursday was active in the north with prices \$2.00-\$3.00 lower at \$129.00-\$130.00 dressed. At time of reporting Friday afternoon, there was light trade reported in the north at \$84.00 live, steady to last week. The south remains untested with asking prices at \$86.00-\$87.00 live.
